

CHILD CODE OF CONDUCT

Respecting others

- I treat adults and other pupils with respect.
- I recognise that everyone has the right to be heard.
- I respect that others are here to learn.
- I look after other people in the school.
- I report bullying or any accident to a school member.
- I respect and follow the agreed class and school rules.

Behaviour

- I answer when I am asked to do something.
- I hold doors open for other people.
- I will not run in the corridors.
- I tidy up using the bins provided.
- I do not use bad language at any time.
- I will turn my mobile phone off during lessons.
- I will attend classes on time and with the right equipment.
- I will let the school know if I am going to be absent.



PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

Safety

- I ensure that pushchairs, buggies, scooters and bikes are left outside of the buildings.
- I can stay in the main hall or in the playground but I am not allowed to access the corridors where classes are held.
- With the exception of the mini classes, I can't stay in class unless agreed with the teacher.
- I supervise my child at all times when in the premises and in particular in the playground.
- I wear my lanyard and I ensure my child wears the school bracelet at all times when in the premises.

Behaviour

- I ensure my child arrives in good time for their lesson.
- I treat school volunteers, teachers and others with respect.
- I let the school know if and why my child is not at school today.
- I attend discussions about my child's progress.
- I don't hold the school responsible if I lose valuables, toys, balls and any other items not necessary during school tuition.

We will not accept any of the following:

- Damage to property
- Persistent refusal to accept school rules/discipline
- Verbal abuse to staff/pupils
- Bullying

- Physical aggression towards staff/pupils
- Sexual misconduct
- Substance abuse
- Theft
